

# WALK IN TRUTH

A philosopher once said, "So long as we are able to distinguish any space whatsoever between the truth and us, we remain outside it." This is so true and so relevant to our day. In a world that is changing very rapidly and in almost every area, the one thing that must remain constant in the church is truth.

We live in a world that resists the idea of absolutes. The courts have difficulty in determining that anything is absolutely illegal. The government has difficulty in determining that there are any absolutes in ethics or morality. Society has given up even trying.

In the midst of all this, we cannot lose sight of the fact that this truth we hold is absolute. The necessity of an Acts 2:38 experience is absolute. While we may vary in our local house rules, there are clearly defined standards of holiness in Scripture; these are absolute!

In a gray world, we dare not lose an understanding that some things are black and white. Saying that one is almost correct regarding truth is like saying one is almost pregnant. We either are or we aren't. Let's not be embarrassed of truth nor be apologetic of it. This truth is settled in heaven. If there is any space between us and truth, we are outside of it.

In John 14:6, Jesus declared that the Holy Ghost was the Spirit of Truth whose purpose was to lead us into truth. It would be fair to conclude that separating from truth is separating from the Holy Ghost. The Word counsels us to buy the truth and don't sell! III John 3 declares that the Christian walk is a walk in truth. In a world that has lost its bearings, thanks be to God for some things that are absolute!
